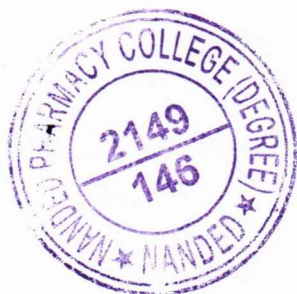



Problems Encountered:

Importance of the Go Green Movement in Daily Life:

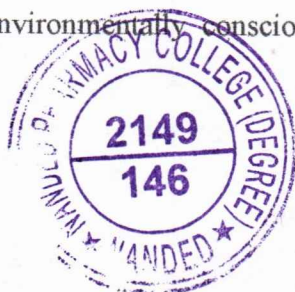


Environment-Friendly Initiatives at Nanded Pharmacy College
